

Dear Parents,

Please do see your child's key person and sign up for a **parent meeting**, it's a great opportunity to see your child's learning journey, discuss your child's progress and agree the next steps for their development.

We had our first **open day** of 2018 this week. I always love hearing prospective parents talk so positively about what they see and hear on their tour. Almost all parents who visit us go on to sign up for a place. We do not have any more spaces left for children who start school in September 2018 but we are still recruiting for children who are due to start primary school in September 2019 and 2020.

If you think you may be eligible for the working parent **30 hours** please get in touch as soon as possible as we have very few of these spaces left. We will give priority to our existing children and especially those who have been with us since they were aged two.

The children are enjoying learning **their rhymes** each week, I hope you're enjoying them at home too!

Headlice and nits are an absolute pain for parents and you will be a very lucky parent if your child goes through their school life without at least one case! They are NOT a sign of dirty hair, in fact they tend to prefer clean hair. The best way to prevent them is to check your child's hair, use conditioner and comb through their hair with a nit comb once a week. If your child has nits then you need to treat the whole family immediately and follow up with the conditioner and comb through every 2-3 days.

The headteacher of Weyfield Primary School has asked me to let you know that Weyfield is proposing to reduce their admission numbers from 60 children to 30 from September 2019.
