Friedrich Froebel (1782 - 1852) was the inventor of kindergartens and a pioneer of early childhood education and care. Froebel's work and writing changed the way we think about and value early childhood.

Froebel's ideas were considered revolutionary in the 1850s but the principles of his work have since become part of modern, mainstream early years educational practice.



The Knife Angel comes to Guildford – 1 to 30 March 2023

As the national monument for anti-aggression, The Knife Angel's singular objective is to bring about social change by educating children, young people and adults about the harmful effects that violent behaviour has on communities all across our nation.

During March, visitors across Surrey and beyond will be able to visit the monument in the grounds of Guildford Cathedral.

During its visit there will be a series of events and workshops to raise awareness of violent crime. Not only does the Angel act as a catalyst for turning the tide on violent and aggressive behaviour, but it is also acts as a beautiful memorial designed to celebrate those lives who have been lost through these violent and thoughtless actions.
