halow project works with more than 200 people with a learning disability on their journey to independence. halow supports them to build relationships and socialise, to feel part of their community, to gain skills to find suitable employment, and the charity assists them with living independently.

Head of Fundraising & Communications Rachelle Barnett said: "halow project is a community-based charity and we are delighted with the response of our local community to 'Love halow'. They have helped us to raise awareness of the many positive impacts of our work and a greater understanding about what people with learning disabilities can achieve with the right support to boost their confidence and Independence. We are so grateful for the funds raised towards our work."

During 'Love halow' month, the people halow supports shared what they love about their charity. halow project also invited the local community to share in the celebration. Local businesses were encouraged to display flyers and posters, and the charity held bucket collections in Tesco Guildford and The Friary. halow would like to thank Tesco and The Friary for welcoming them to collect donations. Thanks to the generosity of their shoppers, halow raised £228.92 at Tesco and £170.58 at The Friary.

The charity would also like to extend a big thank you to Elliott's café in Chiddingfold for donating £60 from sales of their delicious hot chocolate and Karen at Samanya Yoga in Woking, who donated £275 from yoga classes booking fees.

In total, from the support of the local community and businesses, along with the charity's first ever 'text to donate' campaign, they raised £760 over 'Love halow' month. This will be a great help in continuing the charity's work to open opportunities for developing independence for the people they support.
