
Saturday 3rd June 2023 Godalming Town Show from 12 pm

The event takes place on Cranleigh Common, running adjacent to Cranleigh High Street.


The Carnival is a free day out for all the family. There are lots of fun attractions and side shows, plus the ever popular fun dog show.

No need to register, you can just show up on the day!


Join us on the 1st Tuesday of every month 10 - 11.30 am. We'll be there, whatever the weather!
