New group in Bellfields

ANDYSMANCLUB is coming to Guildford!

ANDYSMANCLUB takes its name from Andrew Roberts, a man who sadly took his own life aged 23 in early 2016. Andy was a lovely and doting father, son, brother, grandson, nephew, cousin and friend.

On average one man every two hours takes his life in the UK. It's often said to be a factor that men don't talk. That's why ANDYSMANCLUB was born. Established in 2016 by Luke Ambler, Andy's brother-in-law, the aim of the club is to break down these stigmas, support men struggling and lend a hand to suicide prevention.

The Community Cupboard at Guildford Nursery School Hazel Avenue site is open on Tuesdays and Thursdays, 8:15am - 3:15pm, during term time. It can be accessed by anyone as a way to share or collect food and hygiene products, and is located by the buggy park at the front of the building.

To donate to the Community Cupboard, items can be left in the box located in reception Monday - Friday. Staff will sort donations and put them on display for people to collect.

We are able to accept sealed shelf-stable foods that are within the use-by date, such as cereals, tea, biscuits, fresh fruit and vegetables, tinned and jarred foods; and toiletries.

We are currently unable to accept items that require refrigeration, cooked foods or foods that are unlabelled or out of date.



There is a quiz around the route to keep little ones entertained om the way.


Hot food, hot chocolate, mulled wine, and hot drinks are available at the end in the barn to reward your efforts!
