Why use Makaton?

Research has shown that children who are taught to sign early in their life end up with better skills in reading and spelling later in life.

When using Makaton, children are practising and developing their fine motor skills.

Makaton helps to bring everyone together and involves everyone. Using Makaton at home and in nursery can help the children have a sense of importance, boost their self-confidence alongside their language and communication skills.

An old-fashioned tip to ensure your child's gloves don't go missing: Sew each glove to the end of a long piece of elastic. then thread up one arm of the coat and down the other. Alternatively please name the gloves and hats as so many are going missing. Thank you for your support.
