Abigail, we were so excited to welcome you to Owl room. Evey and I enjoyed visiting you at home with mummy before you started. You were eager to show us your bedroom and enjoyed playing with Evey's bag of sensory toys.

Abigail, you are happy playing independently but are also interested in other children, and will seek out a few others to play with. You sometimes need reminding to use 'gentle hands', especially when you want to share something.

You have been confident exploring all areas of Owl Room, both inside and out in the garden. We have noticed you are often drawn to the clay or playdough table, and are not afraid of getting messy! Here you have taken your time to explore the material with your hands and experimented with how water changes the clay.



In the garden you enjoy chasing other children, using the climbing frames and bouncing on the trampoline with so much joy! You often explore role-play opportunities such as selling ice-creams and pizza with your friends, calling out "Ice-cream, ice-cream!" to encourage people to come and buy from your shop. You are learning where all our resources are kept and are developing relationships with adults, beginning to ask for help when you need it.

You sometimes come to group time where you like singing our 'Hello Song' as well as listening to stories, with adult support. We practise breathing every day, using our breathing ball, alongside learning our new Makaton signs. We look forward to seeing you grow and develop this year, Abigail. We know you're going to have so much fun learning through your play!
